## AHRQ Outpatient Antibiotic Stewardship Training Program

The Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) is currently recruiting practices for a no-cost, 18-month program beginning in June 2024 to promote appropriate antibiotic use while maintaining patient satisfaction and reducing potential side effects. Practices will receive training and one-on-one expert coaching to implement sustainable improvements in the diagnosis and treatment of infections in the telemedicine environment. Eligible practices can offer patient care exclusively via telemedicine or via a mix of inperson and telemedicine visits.

#### Eligible Practice Types

Primary care practices (including internal medicine, family, and pediatrics), outpatient specialty practices that provide primary care (e.g., gynecology), community-based health clinics, student health clinics, retail clinics, occupational health, and urgent care clinics. Whole practices or individual practitioners can participate.



#### **Antibiotic Stewardship Best Practices**

#### Want to clarify penicillin allergies, but don't have access to penicillin skin testing?

The PEN-FAST tool helps identify patients with low-risk allergies by asking only 3 questions.





This eliminates the need for challenging and costly penicillin skin testing for low-risk patients and increases first-line antibiotic options.

#### Penicillin Allergy Decision Rule (PEN-FAST) Identifies low-risk penicillin allergie INSTRUCTIONS When to Use V Five years or less since reaction Anaphylaxis or angioedema Ireatment required for reaction 1 points **5** % PEN-FAST Score Low risk of positive penicillin allergy tes

#### INTERVENTION

377 Participants analyzed (PEN-FAST score <3)



Skin prick and intradermal penicillin testing, followed by oral challenge if skin testing results are negative



#### 187 Intervention

Direct oral penicillin drug challenge

#### FINDINGS

The intervention was found to be noninferior to the control for the primary outcome in adults with low-risk penicillin allergy

> Proportion of participants with a positive oral penicillin challenge

Intervention

Risk difference, 0.0084 (90% CI, -1.22 to 1.24) percentage points which is less than the noninferiority margin
